SCALING THE WORK AT AGIR-IVORY COAST

HHTN Global Director, Rev Joseph Nyamutera travelled to Ivory Coast at the beginning of the new year to meet our able colleagues, Team AGIR.

From a very humble beginning, the team has consistently shown deep commitment to the ministry of reconciliation through running HHTN workshops in the capital and rural areas. The workshops, though conducted randomly, due to financial constraints, have helped greatly to address the effects of 2010 Post Election crisis in the country. To date, the team of volunteers has successfully run 7 Schools of Reconciliation, several trainings and a few workshops.

Despite many accomplishments, they have been faced by several challenges; the team found itself scattered, dealing with divided attention and loyalties, which has led to the loss of a big number of trainees.

Over the years, God redeemed the team's lack of external support and organisational fragmentation by; giving the team creative ways of raising funding locally and giving them a good reputation of a church owned ministry rather than an NGO. The absence of big funding underscored the unwavering passion of the few who persevered without a salary, but instead contributed financially and sacrificially. By God's miraculous intervention, and as the result of fervent prayers, AGIR has finally gotten a small funding to run a structured project concurrently with other reconciliation events locally funded.

Joseph conducted sessions on organisational skills and helped them in setting up an organisational structure.
