The Process: A journey rooted in a fresh and deep encounter with the crucified and resurrected Lord Jesus Christ, leading to healing, restoration and transformation.



The Promise: A healed heart, restored identity and deep reconciliation with God, ourselves, others and creation.

HHTN Global Ministry Focus



