West African School of Reconciliation (WASOR) 2025 will take place at Mt. Sinai Prayer Centre in Monrovia, Liberia, from **May 27 to June 8, 2025**.

The school will have 3 sections:

It begins with the Healing Hearts Transforming Nations (HHTN) Workshop, followed by a Training of Facilitators Course, where participants learn to lead HHTN Workshops. This is then followed by a practicum workshop, providing participants with the opportunity to teach HHTN workshops in the community under coaching and supervision.

You may do the HHTN Workshop without the Training of Facilitators course, but taking part in the HHTN Workshop is a prerequisite to doing the Training of Facilitators Course and practicum workshops. Once you have done the three sections, you will have completed WASOR 2025.

- Healing Hearts Transforming Nations (HHTN) Workshop: **27 - 31 May 2025** (Arrival on 27th and Departure on 31st)
- Training of Facilitators: **1 - 5 June 2025**
- Practicum Workshops **6 - 7 June 2025** (Departure on 8th June)

What is HHTN?

The HHTN Workshop seeks to bring healing and wholeness to communities suffering from division, wounding and hatred; and to equip Christians to be agents of healing and reconciliation. People from differing backgrounds are invited to encounter God and one another at a heart level. In a safe environment, participants are encouraged to engage in the healing process and be open to develop new perspectives and attitudes.

Why is HHTN Needed?

West Africa, and Africa as a whole, continues to suffer from deep historical wounds, ongoing ethnic and religious conflicts, civil wars, terrorism and divisions within families and churches. Many communities remain traumatised by these challenges, highlighting the urgent need for reconciliation, transformation and healing. Addressing both personal and societal wounds is essential to restoring families, strengthening churches and rebuilding communities.

What Can Participants Expect from the HHTN Workshop?

- A new and fresh encounter with God and with one another
- A deeper revelation of truth of Christ that leads to freedom
- An opportunity for people to hear each other and express their pain in a safe environment
- The healing of heart-wounds at the Cross, enabling forgiveness and repentance
- Increased awareness of personal prejudices and judgements towards other people
- Demolishing dividing walls between different peoples and different people groups
- Moving towards embracing the other as Christ embraces us

What is the Objective of the Training of Facilitators and Practicum Workshops?

The training and practicum seek to equip HHTN facilitators who will creatively use the material to facilitate healing and reconciliation in their communities and in the nations.

Who Should Attend the Training of Facilitators?

- Someone who has completed the HHTN workshop and has begun to experience their own healing
- Someone who is a committed Christian and has a reasonable knowledge of the Bible
- Someone who has a good reputation within their community and local church setting
- Someone who has support from their church or organisation to attend this course and apply the training
- Someone who is able to understand, creatively apply and communicate the material
- Someone who is teachable, a good listener, has a servant heart and compassion for others
- Someone who is willing and available to give some time to the ministry of healing and reconciliation
